Educational Program

I. Programming and Curriculum

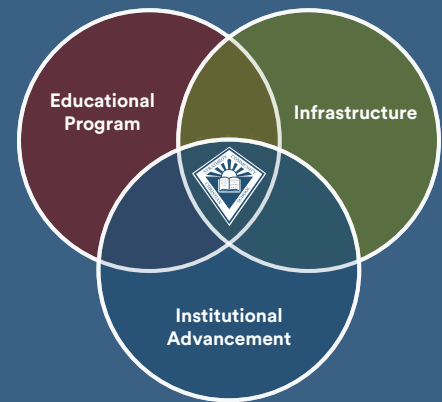
- Provide a God-centred, holistic, consistent, comprehensive and coherent curriculum plan from JK through grade 8 that aligns with the SCCS mission and vision and Ontario Ministry of Education guidelines.
- Hire a Principal/DSO whom reflects the Mission and Vision of SCCS, that will encourage Academic Excellence and Spiritual Growth of all students and Staff, and encourage visibility of SCCS within our community and the world.
- Explore the creation of report cards that reflect academic, spiritual, social, emotional, and physical growth of students.
- Hire and sustain passionate, qualified staff that provide excellent and engaging instruction following the Mission and Vision of SCCS and continue to participate in ongoing professional development.
- Gather meaningful academic assessment data using a variety of tools.
- Optimize enrollment and assessment strategies for International/ESL students.

II. Individual Student Academic Success

- Provide opportunity for individual student success for students with exceptionalities through Bridge programming and Social Work services
- Improve individual and school-wide MAP scores.
- Provide experiential and diverse education within and between grades.
- Ensure access to current information technology to enhance student learning.

III. Engagement and Service

- Participate in opportunities to provide service between students, student and school, student and family, and students and community.
- Engage in global partnership with an international school and/or engage in a partnership with a local school in the same community.



Infrastructure

I. Tech Infrastructure

- Provide 1:1 device ratio by implementing a class-set purchase of new chromebooks every year.
- Supply each room with cutting edge teaching technology like document cameras, and Google Chromecast (or comparable technology) to create interactive presentation whiteboards.
- A new fleet of Android tablets so that we will be a one-platform school which will allow for easier device management for our Tech Department.

II. Building Infrastructure

- Complete the full scope of the building project that has been approved by the membership.
- Inventory and plan future general maintenance needs (e.g. roof, HVAC, parking lot, gym equipment).
- Continue to update current classrooms/ learning spaces with furniture/ layouts that are more conducive to flexible and active learning approaches.

Institutional Advancement

I. Profile

- Increase SCCS's visibility and profile within the wider Strathroy-Caradoc-West London community.

II. Fundraising

- Complete capital campaign for building renovations and addition.
- Modernize our fundraising and financial support strategies for greater accessibility and effectiveness with current families.

III. Enrolment

- Increase enrolment to the capacity of our planned facilities (about 225 students) by 2025.
- Expand resources to assist families with financial needs or with children having special needs.
- Sustain international student recruitment to make up 5-10% of our student population.

- Improve communication of day-to-day details from school administration and teachers to parents.
